Title: The Joint Concept for Logistics: Enabling Globally Integrated Logistics

Participant Desired Experience – **intermediate**

The Joint Concept for Logistics (JCL) considers how an evolving Joint Logistics Enterprise (JLEnt) could better support joint operations in a future characterized by the challenge of meeting unremitting strategic requirements with constrained military resources. The Capstone Concept for Joint Operations: *Joint Force 2020* established Globally Integrated Operations as the future joint operational concept designed to meet that challenge. With the requirement for rapid aggregation of globally distributed forces, globally integrated operations create a logistically demanding approach. This concept proposes GIL as a possible solution for meeting those demands.

This session will introduce the precepts which define the characteristics of GIL, as well as the capabilities which the Joint Force will require to attain these conditions.
