Title: Integrated Booking System (IBS) and Global Air Transport Execution System (GATES)

Abstract: NOTE: This class is designed for all experience levels for this topic.

IBS is the lead execution system of the Defense Transportation System (DTS) for the global shipment of ocean cargo in support of all wars, major contingencies and humanitarian relief operations. IBS provides SDDC the capability to electronically procure commercial transportation services for the global strategic deployment of DOD-sponsored cargo. GATES automates support for receipt, movement and billing of cargo and passengers. It is the information system that sends ITV data to SDDC HQ.

This session will include a system demonstration of IBS and GATES business systems and address user compliance issues.
