To provide an overview of America's combat logistics support agency with a specific focus on distribution operations. DLA provides the military services, other federal agencies and partner nation armed forces with a full spectrum of logistics, acquisition and technical services. DLA sources and provides nearly all of America's military consumable items needed to operate – from food, fuel and energy to uniforms, medical supplies and construction material. DLA also supplies nearly 90 percent of the military's spare parts, manages the reutilization of military equipment, provides catalogs and other logistics information products, and offers document automation and production services.
