**Title:** Planning and Booking Utilizing Export Traffic Release Requests

**Abstract:** NOTE: This class is designed at the following experience level for this topic – All Levels.

SDDC plans, directs, monitors, and assesses cargo movement requirements across the globe. The planning process takes in to account customer desires, brigade/battalion capabilities, and enterprise constraints and restraints (i.e., Laws, Defense Transportation Regulations, etc.) to meet mission requirements. SDDC utilizes Export Traffic Release Requests to facilitate the booking of cargo on commercial vessels. Highlighted during the session will be preferred methods of shipping cargo within the booking, shipping, tracking, and billing processes. Takeaways: A better understanding of SDDC's capabilities and processes, and the importance of identifying cargo movement requirements early.
